## WHY WE DID THIS

We are currently experiencing the highest inflation rate in 40 years. Due to the nature of their work and sources of income, nonprofits are in a precarious position as they work to support their staff and clients. This year, many of our grantee partners have shared their efforts to increase salaries and make improvements to their operations to meet these challenges. As a funder that is committed to supporting the resiliency of the nonprofits that serve our rural community, supplementing our 2022 grantmaking in this way made good sense.

## GRANT DETAILS

This September a total of \$33,080 was granted to 12 organizations with program restricted grant funding with the foundation. Approximately 10% was granted based on each organization's existing program restricted grant with the foundation.
